### What is OFFN?

The OneOklahoma Friction Free Network is a statewide research network. OFFN utilizes OneNet's network infrastructure and provides 10 to 100 Gbps connectivity to give higher education institutions a dedicated alternative route to traditional internet pathways. This allows researchers, faculty and students to access supercomputing resources across the state and allows for faster data transfer.

## Why Should You Use OFFN?

You need access to a supercomputer to process large datasets.

You need to collaborate with colleagues at other institutions across the state, nation and world.

You need to move and share big data.

You have technical instrumentation that generates large volumes of data.

You need access to global scientific instrumentation.

You want to teach supercomputing or big data mining principles.
